

Grant and Project Funding

- Nevada Governor's Council on Development Disabilities (NGCDD) Funding for a 35-minute animated training video for their Youth Empowering Students (Y.E.S.). Training provided for ~65 adolescents with disabilities each year. Stakeholders gave the video their highest rating.
- Wyoming Arts Council (WY Arts) Completed the 2022-2023 Voice Project grant that funded acting, voice, and expression training for 36 DSPs and people with disabilities. Trainer was Dominic Syracuse from Cognitive Behavioral Theater.
- Wyoming Arts Council (WY Arts) Received funding for a portion of the 2023-2024 Finding Your Voice project that will provide training to people with disabilities on civil rights and civic engagement.
- Overture (Day, Employment, and Residential Services for People with Disabilities) Through Overture's funding from the Wyoming Department of Health, ARPA Technology Innovation Grant, Encore was contracted to develop virtual reality training courses for people with disabilities.
- Wyoming Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities (WGCDD) Provided funding for a portion of the 2023-2024 Finding Your Voice project under the Bright Ideas grant.
- Wyoming Department of Workforce Services (WY DWS) Funded the compensation for Training Manager to provide professional learning deliverables.
- Wyoming Department of Workforce Services (WY DWS) Funds the compensation for Training Development Coordinator, who is helping develop grant deliverables.
- Overture (Day, Employment, and Residential Services for People with Disabilities) Funded by ARPA 2, Overture contracted with Encore for continuation of virtual reality training experiences.
